Nominees must be members who are in good standing, for at least 4 months immediately preceding the election. (Article X, Section 1D). If you are nominating an individual for an office, you must notify that person and verify that the person is willing to serve before you complete the nomination process. Upon agreement of the individual to be nominated, complete the nomination form specifying the nominee's name, MACA Chapter affiliation and their address and telephone number.

The Election Committee must confirm all nominees acceptance in writing, so please provide accurate contact information.

ALL nominations must be received by November 15, 2009.

ELIGIBLE VOTERS

The MACA constitution provides that "only members in good standing can vote at all general membership meetings. Membership in good standing is conferred on those whose membership dues are current.

BALLOTS

Upon closure of the nomination period, a ballot will be sent to all members in "good standing". Each person who is nominated and wishes to be a candidate may provide a "candidates statement". The statement must be sent to the Election Committee Chair by November 15, 2009.
